

## **Privacy Policy**

- A) Consent – By using this website, you signify your consent to us collecting and using personal data about you as specified below in accordance with this policy statement. Should we choose to change these terms for any reason, the changes will be posted here so that you are always kept informed about the collection and use of your personal information, and when we disclose it.
- B) How we may collect personal information about you and how we use it
- You may provide personal information when communicating with us.
  - You may use our services and give your name and e-mail address to make a comment about our services or web site.
  - If you apply for a job vacancy, the personal data you provide on the online form will be sent electronically to our Administration Team, and once we have contacted you by telephone, should you be a suitable candidate your information will also be shared with the interviewer.   - We will collect information about your interest in the site when you tell us and by analysis of customer traffic, including using “cookies”.
  - We may use personal information collected about you to help us develop the layout of our website to ensure that our site is as useful, easy and enjoyable as possible.
  - We may use personal information collected about you to let you know about functions on our web site or changes to our terms and conditions of use.
- C) Traffic data – We may provide aggregate statistics about sales, customers, traffic patterns and information to third parties, but these statistics will not include any information that identifies you.
- D) Disclosure policy – Your personal information will never be passed onto a third party. However, we reserve the right to access and disclose individually identifiable information to enable us to comply with applicable laws and lawful Government requests to operate its systems and to protect itself or its users.
- E) How do we protect your information? We have strict security procedures covering the storage of your information in order to prevent unauthorized access and to comply with the terms of The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). This means that sometimes we may ask you for proof of identity or for other personal information before we can process your enquiry further.
- F) What are cookies and how are they dealt with? A cookie is a piece of information that is stored on your computer’s hard drive. It is normally sent by a web server to you and enables the server to collect information back from your site visit.
