Dear Hackle Team Member,

As I am sure you are aware by now, Boris Johnson has, this evening, announced increased restrictions over COVID-19.

The Prime Minister has said that, all shops apart from food stores and chemists, must close immediately and meeting friends will be banned.

People will be allowed to leave their homes for the following reasons:

- Shopping for basic necessities
- One form of exercise per day
- Any medical need or to provide care or to help a vulnerable person
- Travelling to and from work, but only where this is necessary and cannot be done from home

It has been announced that these measures will remain in place for a minimum period of three weeks; at which time they will be reviewed further.

What does this mean for Hackle Employees?

Unless you receive notification that the premises where you work is to close, and you are no longer required, you should make every effort to get to work. Unfortunately, the majority of Hackle Services employees are not in a position where they can do their job at home.

The Hackle Management team will update you at the very earliest opportunity, should anything change with regards to your requirement to work or the government guidelines.
